

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND RECOGNIZING THE PAID HOLIDAY SCHEDULE  
FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR OF 2015**

**17 December 2014**

**Resolution No. 2014-18**

**RECITALS**

WHEREAS, the Aurora Election Commission (“ELECTION COMMISSION”) is a government entity, organized and existing pursuant to the Election Code, 10 ILCS 5/1-1, *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the ELECTION COMMISSION is authorized and empowered, pursuant to the Illinois Election Code, 10 ILCS 5/1-1, *et seq.*, to pass resolutions for the purpose of carrying out its statutorily enumerated duties and responsibilities and those powers reasonably inferred therefrom; and

WHEREAS, the ELECTION COMMISSION seeks to inform and provide its staff and the registered voters of the City of Aurora of the holidays in which the ELECTION COMMISSION will be closed and the staff will receive compensation; and

WHEREAS, the ELECTION COMMISSION remains open during many holidays that banks, State Government, Federal Government and County Government observe; and

WHEREAS, the ELECTION COMMISSION acknowledges the importance of notifying the public of holiday closers so that residents can conveniently register to vote; and

WHEREAS, the ELECTION COMMISSION seeks to close its office in observance of the following holidays: News Year’s Day, January 1, 2014; Memorial Day, May 26, 2014; Independence Day, July 4, 2014; Labor Day, September 1, 2014; Veterans Day, November 11, 2014; Thanksgiving, November 27, 2014; the Friday after Thanksgiving, November 28, 2014; Christmas Day, December 25, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the ELECTION COMMISSION seeks to keep its Office open for a half day in observance of the following holidays: Christmas Eve, December 24, 2014; New Year’s Eve, December 31, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the ELECTION COMMISSION shall post the holiday closures on its website and post a sign, no less than two (2) business days prior to the holiday, informing the public of the closure; and

WHEREAS, the ELECTION COMMISSION finds that the suggested holiday dates would

comport with the practice among private enterprises and public entities and would not deleteriously affect the services the ELECTION COMMISSION renders to the residents of the City of Aurora; and

WHEREAS, the ELECTON COMMISSION finds that it is in the best interest of the ELECTION COMMISSION and the citizens of the City of Aurora to adopt a formal Holiday Schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Election Commission, as follows:

1. That the recitals set forth above are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.
2. That the Board of Commissioners hereby adopts and recognizes the Holiday Schedule in which the ELECTION COMMISSION will close its Office in observance of the following holidays: News Year's Day, January 1, 2015; Martin Luther King Day, January 19, 2015 (unless a Consolidated Primary required; Office will be open); Memorial Day, May 25, 2015; Independence Day, July 4, 2015 (July 3, 2015 Observed); Labor Day, September 7, 2015; Veterans Day, November 11, 2015; Thanksgiving Day, November 26, 2015; the Friday after Thanksgiving Day, November 27, 2015; Christmas Day, December 25, 2015.
3. That the Board of Commissioners hereby adopts and recognizes the Holiday Schedule in which the ELECTION COMMISSION will remain open for a half day in observance of the following holidays: Christmas Eve, December 24, 2015; New Year's Eve, December 31, 2015.
4. That the ELECTION COMMISSION shall pay its employees the appropriate holiday benefit, which is based on the average work hours scheduled per week.
5. The Personnel Policy pertaining to the day before and the day after a holiday schedule shall apply.
6. That the ELECTION COMMISSION shall post the holiday schedule on its website.
7. That the ELECTION COMMISSION shall post a sign no less than two (2) days before the Office closing informing the residents of the closing.
8. That all resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
9. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage,

approval and publication, in the manner provided for by law.



**PURPOSE:**

This is to schedule for the 2015 Calendar year the holidays that the office will observe by being closed and paying staff the appropriate holiday pay. If a scheduled Election prevents the office from closing, the staff will receive the day's pay plus the holiday pay.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Aurora Election Commission will close the office and staff to be paid the appropriate holiday benefit. Appropriate is based on average hours schedule per week. The employee will have met the office policy regarding the day before and day after holiday schedule. The Election Commission does maintain a website and it will be posted as the holidays for the year that will be observed as well as a reminder notice as each holiday approaches. There will also be a sign posted no less than two (2) business days that the office will be closed for the holiday and when the office will reopen to the public.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Board approve from the following days as paid holidays in which the office will be closed for the 2015 Calendar Year.

New Years Day (Observed January 1, 2015)  
MLK January 19, 2015 (if Primary, office will be opened)  
Memorial Day (May 24, 2015)  
July 4<sup>th</sup> (July 3, 2015 Observed)  
Labor Day (September 07, 2015)  
Veterans Day (November 11, 2015)  
Thanksgiving (November 28, 2015)  
Friday after Thanksgiving (November 29, 2015)  
Christmas Eve ½ day (December 24, 2015)  
Christmas Day (December 25, 2015)  
New Years Eve ½ day (December 31, 2015)
