

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING ELECTION EQUIPMENT SERVICES
OF ROBIS ELECTIONS, INC.**

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Aurora Election Commission (“ELECTION COMMISSION”) is a body politic and corporate, organized and existing pursuant to the Election Code, 10 ILCS 5/1-1, *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the ELECTION COMMISSION is authorized and empowered, pursuant to the Illinois Election Code, 10 ILCS 5/1-1, *et seq.*, to pass resolutions for the purpose of carrying out its statutorily enumerated duties and responsibilities and those powers reasonably inferred therefrom; and

WHEREAS, the ELECTION COMMISSION is authorized and empowered, pursuant to the Illinois Election Code, 10 ILCS 5/1-1, *et seq.*, to approve election equipment services provided to the ELECTION COMMISSION by contractors for the purpose of carrying out its statutorily enumerated duties and responsibilities and those powers reasonably inferred therefrom; and

WHEREAS, Robis Elections, Inc. has performed services for the ELECTION COMMISSION in a manner acceptable to the ELECTION COMMISSION and the ELECTION COMMISSION desires to approve said services; and

WHEREAS, the ELECTION COMMISSION finds that the approval of the election equipment services provided by Robis Elections, Inc. is in the best interest of the ELECTION COMMISSION and the citizens of the City of Aurora.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Election Commission, as follows:

1. That the recitals set forth above are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.
2. That the Board of Commissioners hereby approves the services performed by Robis Elections, Inc. detailed in Exhibit A in the amount of \$12,980.00.
3. That all resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage,

approval and publication, in the manner provided for by law.


