## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE FUNDING AND ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSES OF MAILING VOTER IDENTIFICATION CARDS

## RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Aurora Election Commission ("ELECTION COMMISSION") is a government entity, organized and existing pursuant to the Election Code, 10 ILCS 5/1-1, et seq.; and WHEREAS, the ELECTION COMMISSION is authorized and empowered, pursuant to the Illinois Election Code, 10 ILCS 5/1-1, et seq., to pass resolutions for the purpose of carrying out its statutorily enumerated duties and responsibilities and those powers reasonably inferred therefrom; and

WHEREAS, the ELECTION COMMISSION is authorized and empowered, pursuant to the Illinois Election Code, 10 ILCS 5/6-21, to incur all debts necessary for expenses related to governing and managing the commission; and

WHEREAS, the ELECTION COMMISSION is to provide Voter Identification Cards in connection with all voters who's voter status has changed since the last election, including those impacted by the Ward redistricting of the City of Aurora, the State and Federal Representative redistricting and the alteration of Precinct Boundaries; and

WHEREAS, following the decennial census the boundaries for various Election Districts have been altered as required by law, in some instances, altering the Precinct Boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the ELECTION COMMISSION seeks to notify all impacted voters of their current status and legislative and other voting district information through the use of a Voter Identification Card; and

WHEREAS, there is a substantial to the ELECTION COMMISSION for said notification, through the mailing of the Voter Registration Card; and

WHEREAS, in order to keep the electorate informed of the vital voter and election information, the ELECTION COMMISSION deems it in the best interests of the residents it serves to fund the mailing of the Voter Identification Cards and to mail said Cards to the affected Voters.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Election Commission, as follows:

- 1. That the recitals set forth above are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.
- 2. That the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the ELECTION COMMISSION to segregate and fund the mailing of Voter Identification Cards to affected voters.
- 3. That all Resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
- 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, in the manner provided for by law.
- 5. That the Executive Director is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Attorney for the Election Commission at 400 S. Knoll, Unit C, Wheaton, Illinois 60187.
- 6. The Executive Director is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Office of the Chief Judge of the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit, 37W777 Route 38, St. Charles, Illinois 60175.
