

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-02

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING
THE AURORA ELECTION COMMISSION
PERSONNEL POLICY**

WHEREAS, the Aurora Election Commission (“ELECTION COMMISSION”) is a body politic and corporate, duly organized and existing under the Election Code, 10 ILCS 5/1-1, *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the ELECTION COMMISSION possesses the full power to pass all necessary ordinances, resolutions, rules, regulations and procedures for carrying into effect the objects for which the ELECTION COMMISSION was formed and to discharge its statutory obligations in accordance with the Election Code; and

WHEREAS, the ELECTION COMMISSION possesses the power, pursuant to the Election Code, to make all reasonable rules and regulations, not inconsistent with the Election Code, including but not limited to, adopting a personnel policy for its employees, election judges and independent contractors in accordance with 19 ILCS 5/6-26; and

WHEREAS, the ELECTION COMMISSION has reviewed the proposed Personnel Policy, and has determined it to be in the best interest of the ELECTION COMMISSION to approve said Policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ELECTION COMMISSIONERS OF THE AURORA ELECTION COMMISSION, AT A DULY CONVENED OPEN MEETING THAT:

SECTION ONE: That the recitals set forth above are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

SECTION TWO: That the Personnel Policy, for the ELECTION COMMISSION, which is attached hereto and hereby made a part hereof as Exhibit “A”, be and the same is hereby adopted and approved.


SECTION THREE: That the Executive Director of the ELECTION COMMISSION is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Ordinance and is hereby authorized and directed to file a copy of the same with the Chief Judge of the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit, at 540 South Randall Road, St. Charles, Illinois 60174, and the Mayor of the City of Aurora, at 44 East Downer Place, Aurora, Illinois 60507-2067.

SECTION FOUR: That all ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.


SECTION FIVE: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, in pamphlet form, in the manner provided for by law.






